Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus told his disciples in the clearest possible terms that his mission was not to do away with God’s law but to fulfill it. In a series of sayings often called the “antitheses,” Jesus first stated an Old Testament law (“You have heard that it was said”), which he assumes they should continue keeping—and he shows them how (“But I say to you”). Don’t just refrain from killing, says Jesus; root out the anger in your heart that leads to murder. Don’t merely refrain from making false promises; make your word so true and your integrity so trustworthy that you do not have to swear oaths at all. In the reading from 1 Corinthians, Paul continues to meditate on the difference between worldly and divine wisdom. In God’s mysterious wisdom, salvation was accomplished through a mighty act not of power but of weakness: the execution of a criminal condemned by the state.
